## Directions for Friendship Seed Packets — Ornamentals —

- Download the PDF files from <http://homestyle.dailyprogress.com> and click on the link for Friendship Seeds. Print them out on 8 1/2" x 11" paper. Fill in the appropriate information about the name of the plant, whose garden they came from, the growing requirements for the plant, and any other information or personal notations you wish. Cut out around the outside of the seed packet along the solid black line.
- Prefold all four sides of the front panel along the dotted lines.
- Apply chosen adhesive (glue or double-stick tape) on the side of the tab marked "Tape or glue on this panel" and secure the back of the seed pack over this tab.
- Apply tape or glue on the back side of the tab with the newspaper logos and fold over the back, covering up the copyright disclaimer at the bottom of the back panel.
- Place your seeds inside the packet. Make sure that your seeds are fully dried before placing them in the seed packets as any excess moisture might cause them to spoil. We also suggest prewrapping them in a square of wax paper to protect against moisture getting in or loss of very small seeds.
- With the seeds inside the packet, fold the top panel over and glue or tape closed.
- Share your seeds with a fellow gardener.

1. Download the PDF files from <http://homestyle.dailyprogress.com> and click on the link for Friendship Seeds. Print them out on 8 1/2" x 11" paper. Fill in the appropriate information about the name of the plant, whose garden they came from, the growing requirements for the plant, and any other information or personal notations you wish. Cut out around the outside of the seed packate along the solid black line.
2. Prefold all four sides of the front panel along the dotted lines.
3. Apply chosen adhesive (glue or double-stick tape) on the side of the tab marked "Tape or glue on this panel" and secure the back of the seed pack over this tab.
4. Apply tape or glue on the back side of the tab with the newspaper logos and fold over the back, covering up the copyright disclaimer at the bottom of the back panel.
