

Eighth Street Office Building
Originally the Murphy Hotel
Built: 1911-15
Bought by the state, along with the Ninth Street Office Building, in 1966 for \$1.95 million
Planned demolition: \$4.5 million

General Assembly Building
Originally the Life Insurance Company of Virginia Building
Designed: 1912 Additions: 1922, 1955, 1964
Bought by the state, along with the parking garage at Seventh and Marshall streets, in 1972 for \$13 million
Proposed renovation: \$116.8 million-\$192.5 million

Old City Hall
Built: 1887-94
Bought by the state in 2006 for \$7.6 million

Patrick Henry Building
Originally the Virginia State Library and Archives and the Virginia Supreme Court
Built: 1938-40
Original cost: \$1.5 million
Renovated for \$32 million

Oliver W. Hill Building
Originally the State Library Building
Built: 1893-95
Original cost: \$162,000
South wing built: 1909 for \$85,000
Renovated and expanded: 2004-05 for \$26.3 million

Jefferson Building
Originally the Thomas Hunter Blanton Office Building
Built: 1955-56
Cost: \$3.9 million
Renovated for \$12 million

Washington Building
Originally the State Office Building
Built: 1922-23
Original cost: \$1.35 million
Renovated for \$23.5 million

Ninth Street Office Building
Originally the Hotel Richmond
South wing designed: 1904 Lobby, North wing designed: 1911-12
Proposed redevelopment and renovation: more than \$100 million

Virginia State Capitol
Designed by Thomas Jefferson
Opened: 1789
House, Senate chambers added in 1904
Renovated for \$104.5 million
